Instructions for Completing Application

Application must be completed in full prior to plan review and permit approval. Permits are not transferrable as to person or place and are not refundable. Issuance of a permit does not guarantee compliance with any code. Plan reviews note all observed defects and are subject to field corrections. The applicant shall be responsible for obtaining permits, inspections, and payment of fees. If work is started before a permit is issued, the permit fee shall be doubled. Kochville Township reserves the right to utilize a third party reviewer. If a third party reviewer is utilized additional fees shall be assessed. This permit shall not be construed as authority to violate, cancel, or set aside any provisions of this code or other applicable regulations, codes, or laws of the jurisdiction. Section 106.3 of the Fire Code requires all work to remain accessible and exposed for inspection purposes. Section 105.3.5 requires the permit to onsite at all times and be available for Fire Code Official review

Expiration of Permit

A permit shall remain in effect until reissued, renewed, or revoked or for such a period of time as specified in the permit. Permits shall automatically become invalid unless the work authorized by such permit is commenced within 180 days after its issuance, or if the work authorized by such permit is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time the work is commenced.
