

FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT

Ordinance No. 21-01

TOWNSHIP OF KOCHVILLE COUNTY OF SAGINAW

AN ORDINANCE TO AFFIRM AN ENFORCING AGENCY TO DISCHARGE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF KOCHVILLE TOWNSHIP, LOCATED IN SAGINAW COUNTY, AND TO DESIGNATE FLOOD HAZARD AREAS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT, BEING ACT 230 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1972, AS AMENDED.

The Township of Kochville Ordains;

SECTION I

AGENCY DESIGNATED: Pursuant to the provisions of the State Construction Code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Building Official of Kochville Township is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of Kochville Township under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. Kochville Township assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act within the boundaries of Kochville Township.

SECTION II

CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED: Pursuant to the provisions of the State Construction Code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of act 230, of the Public acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the Building Official within Kochville Township.

SECTION III

DESIGNATION OF REGULATED FLOOD PRONE HAZARD AREAS: the following are adopted by reference for the purposes of administration of the Michigan Construction Code are declared to be part of Section 1612.3 of the Michigan Building Code, and provide the content of the "Flood Hazards" section of Table R301.2(1) of the Michigan Residential Code, as follows;

- A. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) entitled Study for Saginaw County, Michigan (All Jurisdictions) dated October 16, 1997, and
- B. The Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMS), map number 26145C0035 (35), 26145C0040 (40), 26145C0075 (75), 26145C0080 (80), 26145C0085 (85), and Map Index 2614CIND0, dated October 16, 1997.

SECTION IV

REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH. Any ordinance of Kochville Township or any parts or provisions thereof, to the extent that they are contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions herein are expressly repealed.

SECTION V

EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall take immediate effect upon the publication of said ordinance and a copy of same shall be available for public use and inspection at the Office of the Township Clerk.

ADOPTION: This Ordinance, known as Ordinance No. 21-01, being the FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE, is hereby declared to have been adopted by the Kochville Township Board, County of Saginaw, State of Michigan, at a regular meeting held on the 25th Day of January, 2021, and ordered to be given publication in a manner prescribed by law.
