RESOLUTION #20-25

**Resolution to Set Public Hearing to Determine the Amount to be Assessed Under the
Kochville Township Special Assessment for Fire Protection**

At a regular meeting of the Township Board of Kochville Township, Saginaw County, Michigan, held on August 17, 2020, at 7:00 o'clock a.m., Michigan Time.

The Supervisor reported to the Board that the estimated costs for funding of fire protection equipment and operations is subject to annual review by the Township Board under Public Act 33 of 1951 (MCL 41.801 et seq.) That Act requires that prior to establishing the assessment roll, a public hearing is required to be held. The Township estimates that approximately \$274,392.00 will be needed for fire protection services. Under Public Act 33, the assessment is to be based upon the taxable value of all lands and premises not otherwise exempt, which are in the assessment district, according to benefits received. The township has determined that, based upon the benefits received by premises which are subject to assessment, the millage assessed should be continued at 2 mills for improved commercial and industrial premises, and 1 mill for all other premises (i.e., agricultural, residential, and unimproved commercial and industrial).

The following resolution was offered by Clerk Machata and seconded by Supervisor Loiacano:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF KOCHVILLE TOWNSHIP,
SAGINAW COUNTY, MICHIGAN, as follows:

1. This Board has previously established a special assessment district to provide fire protection equipment and operations, as authorized under Public Act No. 33 of 1951.

2. The Township Board shall meet in the Kochville Veterans Hall, 3265 Kochville Road, on September 21, 2020, at 7 o'clock p.m. Michigan time, to hear and consider any objections to the proposed special assessment of (2) two mills for improved commercial and industrial premises and one (1) mill for agricultural, residential unimproved commercial and industrial and all other premises not otherwise exempt, for fire protection, equipment and operations.

3. Notice of the hearing shall be given by publishing it one time prior to the hearing in The Saginaw News, a newspaper circulated in the Township, and also by mailing the notices, as required by Act No. 162, Michigan Public Acts of 1962, by first-class mail, postage fully prepaid, to each owner of, or party in interest of, the property to be assessed for the fire protection services in the special assessment district, whose name appears on the last local tax assessment records of the Township, addressed as shown on the tax records. The mailing and the first publication shall be at least ten (10) days before the date of the hearing.


